

T-255 Wins the 2013 Philmont High Adventure Lottery!



Great news: T-255 will be going to Philmont in 2013.

Please mark your calendars and reserve the dates of at least

July 11 through 23, 2013

Philmont is the Boy Scouts of America's oldest national high-adventure base. It covers 137,000 acres - about 214 square miles - of rugged mountain wilderness in the Sangre de Cristo range of the Rocky Mountains in northern New Mexico. Philmont has high mountains dominating rough terrain with elevations ranging from 6,500 to 12,441 feet. Attending Philmont is considered the highlight of any Scout career (ask any member to T-255 who has gone!), and one the reasons why it is extremely difficult to find open slots. **PLEASE DO NOT MISS THIS OPPORTUNITY TO ATTEND PHILMONT.**

Troop 255 has 12 slots, maximum of 10 Scouts, 2 adults. Scouts must be age **14 by July 10, 2013**, or age 13 and completed 8th Grade by July 2013. Former Scouts up to age 20 (DoB: July 10, 1993) qualify as either Scouts or Adults.

It is difficult to predict costs 2 years in advance, and costs will vary depending on side trips. If limited side trips, costs should approximate \$1,500 per person.
